It is the policy of Martins to carry out its business activities with due regard to best practice for environmental management and compliance with relevant environmental legislation.

- Meet and where appropriate, exceed the requirements of Environmental Legislation and Regulatory requirements.

- Reduce energy usage including the use of reclaim heat from refrigeration, installation of variable speed motors and installation of LED lighting.
- Maximise recycling across the Bakeries and Shops.

- Ensure all relevant records and documentation is complete and accurate.
- Assess, monitor and, where possible, reduce to a minimum the impact of our activities on the local and general environment.
- Set and periodically review environmental objectives and targets.
- Have appropriate contingency plans in place to minimise the environmental impact of any potential incidents.
- Promote awareness of and communicate with employees the need for environmental conservation.
- Encourage electronic communication and record keeping to reduce paper usage
